### Age limit

Candidates seeking admission to all UG Programme shall not be more than **22 Years as on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020**. However, 05 years relaxation in the age limit will be given to SC/ST/PWD students. Candidates seeking admission to all PG Programme shall not be more than **27 Years as on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2020**.

However, 05 years relaxation in the age limit will be given to SC/ST/PWD students.

*Note: As per the Pharmacy Council of India and NCTE guidelines, no age limit for D. Pharm., B. Pharm., M. Pharm. and B. Ed. Programme.*

### Admission procedure

The University conducts an all India basis Common Entrance Examination to admit candidates to various U.G. and P.G. Programme offered by the University. The admission will be offered to the students in the order of merit as per the results of entrance examination and the reservation policy of the IGNTU subject to verification of eligibility in the particular programme for which the candidate has applied. In order to strengthen the spirit of quality in higher education, the University reserves the right to decide some minimum of standard for qualifying the entrance examination. The candidates, whose qualifying examination results are not declared at the time of submission of application, can also apply and will be given provisional admission and their admissions will automatically stand cancelled if they fail to secure the required percentage of marks in

their qualifying examination or if they fail in the said examination. The candidates so selected are required to give an undertaking in the format given in the prospectus stating that their admission to any of the programme shall be cancelled if they fail to submit the marks-card of the qualifying examination to the Department concerned at the time of counselling for admission. The University shall not consider the candidates having supplementary examination, ATKT, Backlog or the marks of improvement or the marks of re-evaluation for admission at the time of counselling. The particulars of the Programme, the minimum qualification, exam pattern, and the date and time of entrance exam are given below:
